

The library is excited to announce that they received a grant from NASA's Universe of Learning, the Space Science Institute, and the National Center for Interactive Learning to receive a "Discover Exoplanet Exhibit" to display in the library this summer. This exhibit will tie in nicely to our summer reading theme "Reading Is Out of This World". We will have many space-themed programs at the library focusing on space and the exoplanets, including:

- On June 5 Dr. Channon Visscher will lead a presentation called "Discover Exoplanets" at 7:00pm. Find out what worlds lie beyond our solar system! We'll be exploring the exciting field of exoplanet science.
- On June 9 we will be having a Discover Exoplanets kick-off event from 6-8pm!
