Award Honors Design of Sioux Center’s Wastewater Treatment Plant

The City of Sioux Center, along with engineering firm Bolton & Menk, Inc., won an Outstanding Civil Engineering Award for the Sioux Center wastewater treatment facility, awarded by the American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) - Iowa Section.

The selection process for this award considers contribution to the well-being of people and communities, resourcefulness in planning and in solution of design problems, pioneering in the use of materials and methods, innovations in construction, consideration of impact on environment, and more.

“We strive to achieve excellence through cooperation and progressiveness, and I believe this project represented both of them through coordination with the community, city and Bolton & Menk,” said Sioux Center Wastewater Department Head Zeke Ellis.

Sioux Center’s new Wastewater Treatment Facility was completed in 2019. The new plant treats the water to a higher standard and produce a cleaner effluent than the previous plant. It can treat an average of 2 million gallons daily and serves more than 2,500 residential, commercial, and industrial customers.
